2020 Art Series Riesling

"Lime blossom, coriander, hints of lychee and spring blossom. Galangal, kaffir leaf. The Indian Ocean makes a briny impact on the juicy acidity. Sesame seed. Green apple and talc. Incredible pretty and bright, but soft, too. This has precision, but not a retina-burning laser like Great Southern iterations. Plushness and plumpness is the order of the day. Low yields, small bunches and small berries. Supple. Subtle." **94 points.**
